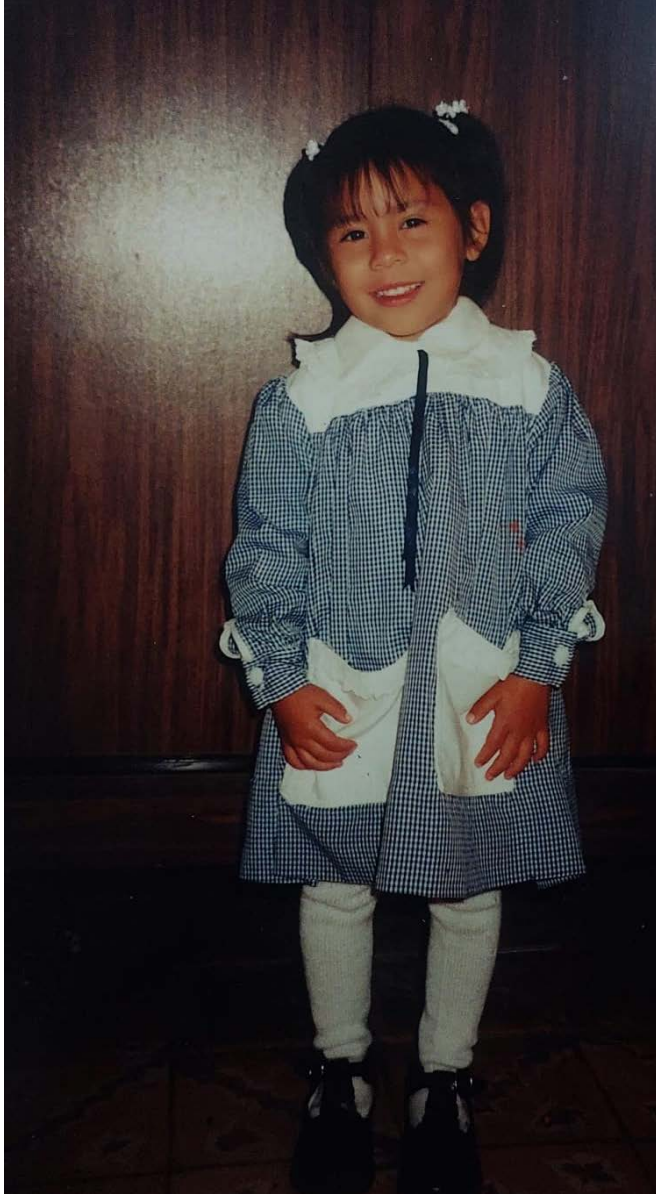
Lúa is a girl, a doll, but a girl, so she does things like girls do.
